JOB DESCRIPTION

Title: Children, Youth, and Young Adult/Families Discipleship Pastor

Purpose: To lead and shepherd the children and youth ministries, guiding them in their spiritual growth, and equipping them to become committed disciples of Jesus Christ.

Key Responsibilities:

- Discipleship and Teaching:
 - o Develop and implement a comprehensive discipleship strategy for children (ages 3 through 5th grade) and youth (grades 6-12) with transition plans to help them grow spiritually from one developmental stage to the next.
 - o Teach and mentor children, youth, and their families (collaborating with the Young Families Ministry) in the Scriptures, guiding them in their walk with Christ.

- o Organize and lead Children's Church, youth groups, small groups (young adult/families), and other discipleship programs.
- Join youth in attending church camp for 1-2 week(s) through Impact2818
 Outdoor Ministry (potentially 2 weeks in 2026).

• Leadership Development:

- o Recruit, train, and mentor volunteer leaders to assist with discipleship of the ministries within an inclusive atmosphere.
- o Equip young people to take on leadership roles within the church.
- o Guide and assist volunteer leaders with related budget, finance, and grant writing as needed for children, youth, young adult/families ministries.

• Event Planning and Execution:

- o Plan and oversee events, fundraisers, service projects, retreats, and mission trips that promote spiritual growth and community.
- o Coordinate outreach activities to engage with the local community and reach unchurched children, youth, and young adults/families.
- o Utilize the church's social media platforms to promote children, youth, young adult, and young families events.
- o Collaborate with the Speedway UMC Child Care Ministry to support the children and families of that ministry and their events.

Pastoral Care:

- o Provide pastoral care, counseling, and support to children, youth, young adults, and their families.
- o Be available to meet with students and parents of the Children, Youth, Young Adult, Young Families, and Child Care ministries as needed.

Collaboration:

- Work closely with other church staff and ministry leaders to align children, youth, and young adult/families with the overall mission and vision of the church
- o Collaborate with Senior Pastor to ensure more routine integration of cross-generational services with the children, youth, and young families into the church.
- o Participate in staff meetings, church events, childcare events, and contribute to the broader life of the church.

Qualifications:

• A mature and growing relationship with Jesus Christ.

- Passion for children, youth, and young adult/families ministry, with experience in teaching, mentoring, and leadership.
- Strong communication, organizational, time-management, relational and creativity skills.
- Ability to connect with and relate to young people in a positive and energetic manner, understanding their unique challenges and needs. Ability to lead children and youth in high energy activities.
- A degree in theology, ministry, or a related field (familiarity with Wesleyan/United Methodist theology preferred), but not required.
- Pass background check and complete trainings in compliance with Safe Sanctuaries regulations.

Accountability: The Children, Youth, and Young Adult/Families Discipleship Pastor reports to the Senior Pastor and works in collaboration with the church leadership team.
